Oregon District 4 welcomes you to the City of Portland and to the beautiful Alpenrose Dairy complex. Alpenrose Dairy is the home of Little League Softball World Series and this year's Oregon Little League State 10-11 Baseball Tournament.

District 4 will not be offering housing for this tournament; however, there are plenty of hotels/motels in SW Portland, Beaverton Lake Oswego and Tigard. These communities are a very short drive from the Alpenrose Dairy site. A hotel list is included in this packet.

This tournament will be pool-play. Please let us know if there are any questions.

Please notify us as soon as a winner is determined in your district. We would very much appreciate having the rosters and name pronunciations emailed to us immediately after your district tournament. District 4 will have a program with only the rosters and jersey numbers of your players. Oregon Little League guidelines recommend that no team photos are printed in our programs

Be very aware of your responsibility to bring affidavits signed by your District Administrator, your league's President and your league's Player Agent. Our tournament staff will also require your league map plotting where your players live (signed by both the league's President and your District Administrator.) We will also require photocopies of your players' birth certificates and the infamous three proofs of residence. No player can play without this REQUIRED information and no exceptions will be allowed. District 4 requires photocopies of your team medical release forms to be in the possession of the team manager at all times. We will also need to have your team's contact information completed at the time of the Manager meeting. Let me know if you have questions about this.

The Managers meeting will be at 3:30pm on Friday July 9th at the Alpenrose Ice Cream Parlor. You will be introduced to one of District Four's Umpire Consultants who will offer you and your coaches the opportunity to clarify any unanswered questions or rule clarifications. This meeting is mandatory.

District 4 and Alpenrose Dairy is hosting an ice cream social for the participating teams and their families. The ice cream social is scheduled to start after the District 4 game on July 10th at 6pm. We will have a tent up on main field. All families are encouraged to come and enjoy some Alpenrose ice cream! No cost to the families! It is essential for your team to participate in the social. Your team's attendance and participation is expected.

From the South: Take Highway 217 North from I-5 North. Take the Greenburg Rd. exit and go right. Greenburg Rd. turns into Oleson Rd. at the Hall Blvd. Intersection. Keep going straight all the way to Vermont St. where you will take a right. Go 1 block and take a left on Shattuck Rd. Alpenrose Dairy is on your left. Enter at the top of the hill.

From the East and North: Take I-5 South to the Multnomah Blvd. exit. Go to 45th and take a right. Go to Vermont St. and take a left. Go to Shattuck Rd. and take a right. Alpenrose Dairy is on your left. Enter at the top of the hill.

From the West (Version #1): Take the Sunset Highway (Hwy 26) to Highway 217 South. Take the Greenburg Rd. exit and go left back over the highway. Greenburg Rd. turns into Oleson Rd. at the Hall Blvd. Intersection. Keep going straight all the way to Vermont St. where you will take a right. Go 1 block and take a left on Shattuck Rd. Alpenrose Dairy is on your left. Enter at the top of the hill.

From the West (Version #2): Take the Sunset Highway (Hwy 26) to Highway 217 South. Take the Canyon Rd. exit. Cross over Canyon Rd. and go to the next stop light which is Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway (I-10). Go left for about 3 miles to Shattuck Rd. Take a right and head up the hill. Alpenrose Dairy will be on your right about 1/2 mile up Shattuck Rd.

Parent Tournament Requirements

Managers MUST have medical releases for all players at all times. Photocopies are required to be in possession of the team manager at all times. No team will be allowed to play unless the medical releases are in the possession of a team manager.

Each team MUST have a first aid kit in their possession at all times while at our game sites. This includes ice packs/bags. It is highly suggested that each team have spare uniforms available for backup. First aid kits must be present at the time that the umps check equipment.

Players will be in complete uniform. This will include a jersey, baseball pants, socks and hats. The appropriate Little League patch must be on the sleeve or chest of the jersey. Shirttails will be tucked into the pants at all times. No player will be allowed to wear white sleeves at anytime.

If a player is injured and removed from the game AND leaves the game site, s/he must have a doctor (or another licensed medical professional) authorize re-entry before that player returns to the game or any future games. Any blood stained article must be removed from the game immediately before that player returns to the lineup.

Players will be inside their dugouts while the opposing team warms up. The exception will be the starting pitchers and their catchers and coaches. No exceptions will be allowed to this request.

Home team will be in the 3rd base dugout and the visiting team will be in the 1st base dugout. As teams are announced onto the field, they will line up from the pitcher's mound to first base (visitors) and from the pitcher's mound to third base (home).

Spectators are forbidden from speaking to managers, coaches or players during the game (it bears repeating!) The managers, coaches AND PLAYERS will be instructed to ignore all comments from spectators, so spectators need to help the team by allowing the managers and coaches to concentrate on the game. This does NOT mean that parents cannot cheer. It means that conversations with players and coaches during the game ARE FORBIDDEN. If an individual is asked more than once to quit conversing with players, the game will be stopped and that spectator will be removed from the stands and they will not be allowed to come back.

Spectators MUST stay out and away from the dugouts during the game. Again, it is expected that no warnings will be issued to any league this tournament season. The consequences are severe!

No banners, signs, balloons, etc., may be placed on fences that might block the view of other spectators. They may be placed on the outside of the fences and the playing area.

The top of the dugouts on the Main field are not to be climbed on and must remain free of people and equipment at all times. Fence lines on all three fields should always be clear. Spectators must be a minimum of two feet behind the fences for their own safety and the safety of those around them.

Gum, glass bottles, and sunflower seeds are not permitted on the Alpenrose facility. They are not sold at the concession stand and cannot be brought on the Alpenrose property at any time.

There is no parking in the red painted curb areas (fire lanes) and any other area marked "No Parking". Parking at or near the concession stand area is reserved for tournament staff only.

To minimize vandalism and to ensure the safety for all, please adhere to the following: ALL Little League participants (players, family members, managers, coaches, etc.) must remain within the areas of play including the restrooms. The Quarter Midget track, (including the stands), the Dirt Bike area, and the Velodrome (Bicycle Race track) are off-limits. Make sure your parents keep all children under control and fully supervised.

Each league will be responsible for:

1. providing one qualified scorekeeper for each game played if requested by tournament staff.
2. having an adult announcer available if needed by tournament staff.
3. providing one adult assigned for policing the facility's non-game areas. This includes keeping children out of any non-baseball areas.
4. field preparation for any game as deemed necessary by tournament staff.
5. cleaning up all areas of the facility after each game, including the bleachers and dugouts. There should be no warnings issued to any leagues this tournament season. This has been a problem for years and for some reason, remains a problem.

Scorekeepers and announcers will not speak to coaches, managers or players on the field during the game without permission of the umpires.
