



Congratulations on winning your district tournament.

Oregon District 4 welcomes you to the City of Lake Oswego and to the beautiful Waluga Park-East baseball complex.

District 4 will not be offering housing for this tournament as all three teams are within a 50 mile radius of Lake Oswego.

This tournament will consist of a double header on Saturday July 10<sup>th</sup>, and the top two teams from the round robin will play for the chance to represent the State of Oregon at Kitsap County Fairgrounds in Bremerton, WA. The Big League Regional games start on Saturday July 17<sup>th</sup> and run through Friday July 24<sup>th</sup>. Please let us know if there are any questions.

Please notify us as soon as a winner is determined in your district. I would very much appreciate having the rosters emailed to me immediately after your district tournament.

Be very aware of your responsibility to bring affidavits signed by your District Administrator, since your team represents a District team. Our tournament staff will also require your league map plotting where your players live (signed by both the league's President and your District Administrator.) We will also require photocopies of your players' birth certificates and the infamous three proofs of residence. No player can play without this REQUIRED information and no exceptions will be allowed. District 4 requires photocopies of your team medical release forms to be in the possession of the team manager at all times. We will also need to have your team's contact information completed at the time of the Manager meeting. Let me know if you have questions about this.

The Managers meeting will be at 11:00am on Saturday July 10<sup>th</sup> at the Waluga Park baseball complex. You will be introduced to one of District Four's Umpire Consultants, Mick Barnitz, who will offer your managers and coaches the opportunity to clarify any unanswered tournament questions or rule clarifications. Kathy Julkowski, the Head Scorekeeper for the tournament, will certify all three teams at that time.

**Please be prepared to travel to Bremerton after winning the Oregon State championship.**

Again, congratulations on your league's success in your District tournament and the District Four tournament staff welcomes you to Lake Oswego. Good luck in the tournament and let's play ball!

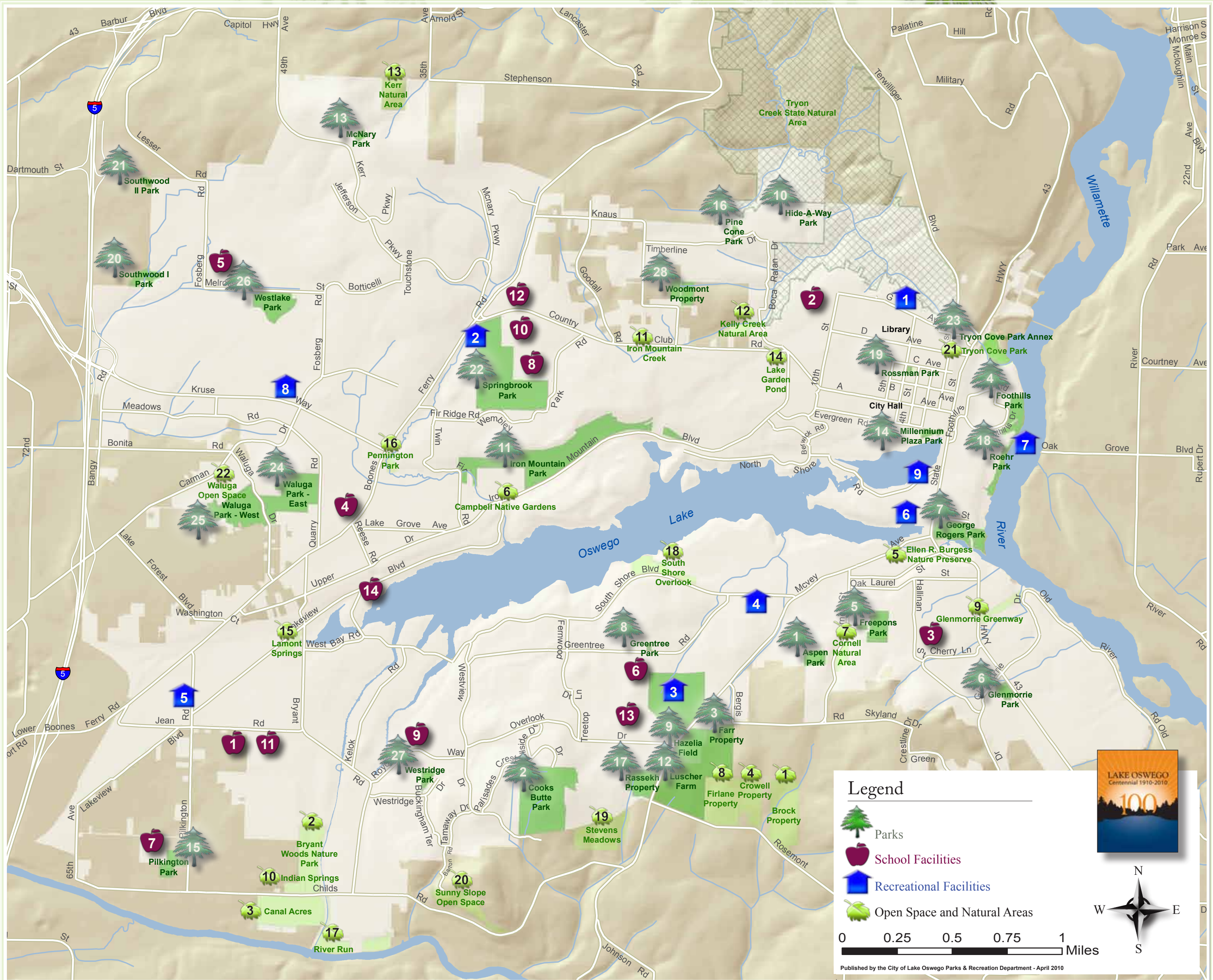

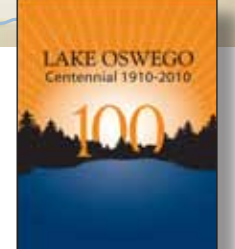
