

Raleigh Hills Little League Boundary Legal Description

Describing an area encompassing the attendance areas of the following Beaverton elementary schools: Greenway, McKay, Montclair, Raleigh Hills, Raleigh Park, and Vose.

Beginning at a point where SW Beaverton Hillsdale Highway crosses the Multnomah/Washington County line (of what would be SW 65nd Avenue). Thence, South along the Washington/Multnomah County boundary in a line that would be SW 65nd Avenue to SW Taylors Ferry Road. Thence, West on SW Taylors Ferry Road to SW Oleson Road. Thence, South on SW Oleson Road to its intersection with SW Hall Blvd. Thence, continuing on a varied course to the South and West along the Attendance Area boundary of McKay Elementary School to the intersection of SW 135th Ave and SW Scholls Ferry Road. Thence, east along the centerline of Scholls Ferry Road to its intersection with 130th Ave. Thence, North along SW 130th Ave and its extension to Brockman Street. Thence, East on Brockman Street to Sorrento Road and North on Sorrento Road to the southern boundary of the Fir Grove Elementary School Attendance Area boundary. Thence, along a varied course which intersects and follows Hall Blvd at several points following along the Greenway and Vose Elementary School boundaries until it intersects SW Allen Blvd. Thence, West along SW Allen Blvd to its intersection with SW Hyland Avenue. Thence, continuing North and East along the Vose ES Attendance Boundary to Erickson Ave. Thence, East along SW 6th and SW 5th Streets to SW Hall Blvd. Continuing North on SW Hall Blvd to SW Farmington Rd. Proceeding Northeast on SW Farmington Road to SW 117th Ave. Thence, North along the centerline of SW 117th Ave and the Raleigh Park Elementary School Attendance Area boundary to SW Walker Road. Proceeding Southeast on SW Walker Rd to its intersection with SW Canyon Rd. Then proceeding Northeast along SW Canyon Road and the Raleigh Park ES Attendance Area boundary to its intersection with SW 78th Ave. Thence, North and East along the Raleigh Park ES Attendance Area boundary to the Multnomah/Washington County line and South to the point of beginning.
